## How to fill out YOUR Story Card.

Keep your eyes open for Jesus at work in your life.

You might share something Jesus is doing through what you experienced at St. Luke, or something that moved you in your Home Group or in conversation with a trusted friend. Perhaps a recent situation at your workplace or a neighborhood restaurant caused you to reflect on Jesus at work around you.

These are not typically heroic stories with grand plot lines; these are simple instances of Jesus at work in small ways. If you are having trouble getting started, you can leave this section blank. Invite a friend to ask you, **“What's Jesus been up to in your life?”**

If this feels awkward or unnatural at first, that's normal. Exploring your answer with another follower will help you fill out your Story Card.
