1. Who is someone you give thanks to Jesus for everything you think of them? Why?
2. The word “partnership” in Philippians 1:5 is the Greek word “koinonia.” It means to have a shared, common participation in something. What is at the heart of the koinonia that Paul has with the Philippians and why is that so important? How is that our koinonia, too?
3. Paul prays that the Philippian’s love (agape) would abound more and more, not just in quantity but also in quality with knowledge and depth of insight. How do knowledge and depth of insight help increase the quality of their love?
