3. In 6:2, do you get the impression that the Apostles are treating this issue as if it's not important? To be sure of your answer, look over the qualifications for doing this ministry as listed in vs. 3

4. Look up in a concordance other times in the New Testament that a "laying on of hands" was enacted as it is described in vs. 6. What was the occasion of the dedication?

5. See vs. 5, then read the end of Chapter 7. Why do you think Luke mentions Stephen at 6:5?

6. What does this account from chapter 6 encourage you or inspire you to do with the gifts and abilities God has given you?
