2. In John's account at 20:1, why do you think it is especially fitting that Mary Magdalene was the first to discover the stone rolled away from the entrance of the tomb?
3. Find, in your Study Bible, the identification of the "other disciple." Why might it be fitting that he was the first to look into the tomb, in this account?
4. See vs 9, realize the disciples still didn't understand; turn to Acts chapter 2. What had to happen in order for the followers of Jesus to understand why Jesus had to rise from the dead?
5. See vs. 17, and read in your Study Bible a reason why Jesus asked Mary to stop holding on to him. . .she had a story to tell. So do you.
